Autologous platelet-rich plasma (PRP), also known as platelet gel and platelet concentrate, is prepared from a patient's centrifuged blood Exposure to a solution of thrombin and calcium chloride degranulates platelets releases the various growth factors and results in the polymerization of fibrin from fibrinogen, creating a platelet gel
